



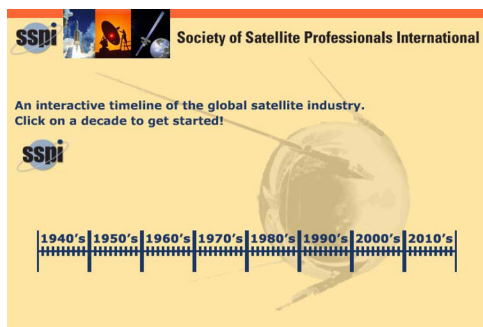

Satellite Timeline

The SSPI Satellite Timeline (www.sathistory.com) is the first interactive Web site to chronicle the rich and diverse history of the commercial satellite industry. The Timeline is an effective tool not only for companies seeking to list their achievements and promote their products and services, but for students, the news media and others who follow the industry and appreciate its contributions to human progress.

Using Flash animation, the Timeline opens up the achievements, decade by decade, since Sir Arthur C. Clarke suggested the concept of a global network of communications satellites in geostationary orbit around the Earth. The Timeline is created by SSPI in consultation with leading educators, publishers and a Board of Advisors responsible for the quality of its content.
